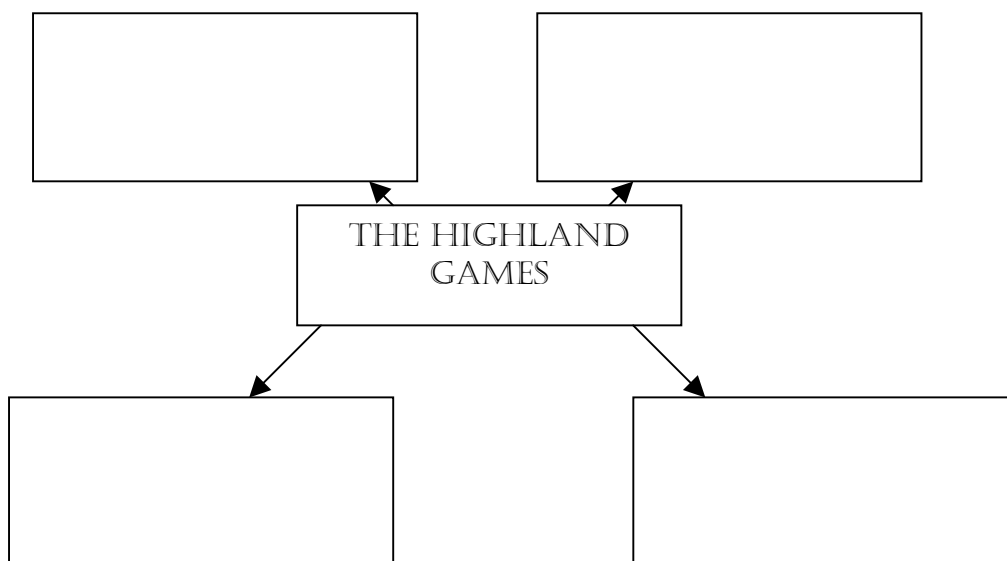

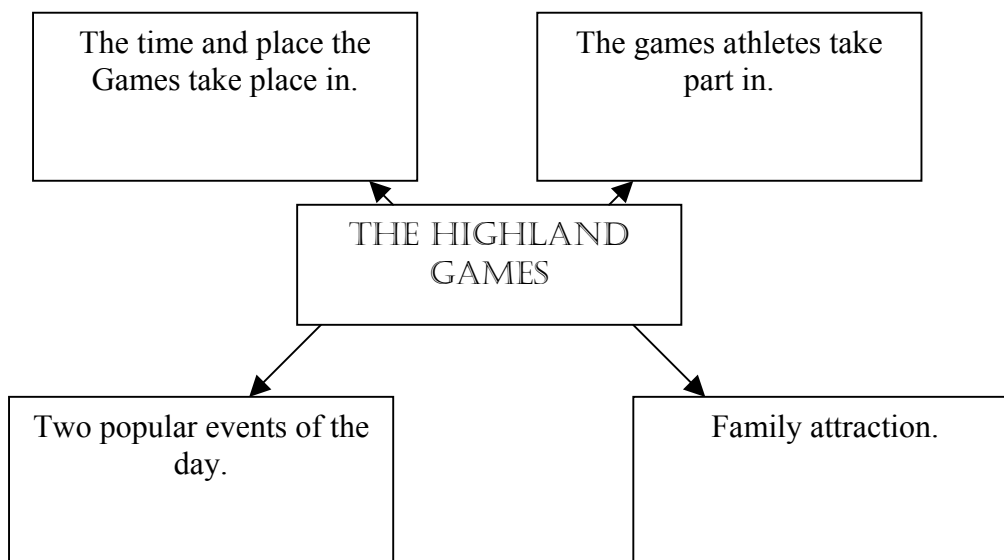
Culture Corner
